VIEWER'S CHOICE CATEGORY Check the appropriate box for your quilt.

- Mini Quilt: perimeter is 96 inches or less, no side larger than 24 inches
- Hand Quilted Small: perimeter is 180 inches or less; hand quilted, may be machine pieced, at least one side larger than 24 inches
- Hand Quilted Large: perimeter is greater than 180 inches; hand quilted, may be machine pieced
- Machine Quilted Small: perimeter is 180 inches or less; pieced and quilted by the same person
- Machine Quilted Medium: perimeter is greater than 180 inches, equal to or less than 285 inches; pieced and quilted by the same person
- Machine Quilted Large: perimeter is greater than 285 inches; pieced and quilted by the same person
- Duet or Group Quilted Small: perimeter is 180 inches or less; more than one person worked on the quilt
- Duet or Group Quilted Medium: perimeter is greater than 180 inches, equal to or less than 285 inches; more than one person worked on the quilt
- Duet or Group Quilted Large: perimeter is greater than 285 inches; more than one person worked on the quilt
- Miscellaneous: items which are not quilts, such as pillows or clothing
